## **ELIGIBILITY**

This event is open to any skater who is 50 years or older by December 31, 2024. Anyone with a desire to perform on ice while wearing skates (figure, speed, or hockey) is invited to participate.

## **REGISTRATION**

All registration will be through [wyomingseniorolympics.org](http://wyomingseniorolympics.org). The registration deadline is March 1, 2024, by 11:59 p.m.

## **EVENTS OFFERED**

- **Emotional Performance**: Showcase program utilizing intense emotional skating quality to depict a theme.
- **Light Entertainment**: Showcase program emphasizing such choreographic expressive qualities such as comedy, love and mime while incorporating skating skills.

Props are allowed but not mandatory.

Props, defined as portable objects distinct from the skater, are allowed for all events. All props must be placed on the ice and removed from the ice by the skater in 30 seconds or less. Props must be able to enter and leave the ice through the same entrances the skater uses. No additional accommodations will be made for oversized props.

Specifically prohibited props include: anything that would affect the ice surface (such as fire, dry ice, liquids, bubble machines, glitter, glass, etc), animals or people, and dangerous props that may harm the skater or audience.

No feathers on costumes or props.

Suggested music length is 1:30-2:00 minutes.

## **MUSIC**

Music should be submitted to [wyomingseniorolympics@gmail.com](mailto:wyomingseniorolympics@gmail.com) by March 1, 2024, at 11:59 pm. Please label your music in the following format for submission:

Suggested music length for all events is 1:30-2:00 minutes.

## **REFUND POLICY**

Refunds will be given for any event(s) cancelled by the Committee except in the case of highway or road closures or other conditions out of the control of the event planners. Refunds for medical and other reasons must be requested in writing and will be assessed a \$10.00 processing fee. No refunds after March 1, 2024. Registration closes March 1, 2024, at 11:59 pm. Late entries will not be accepted. A valid form of identification must be presented at check-in to verify age.
